Old Greenwich has two major parks, the 22-acre Binney Park and 147-acre Greenwich Point. Binney Park incorporates a picturesque duck pond with lovely stone bridges, trails, three ballfields, four tennis courts and a children's playground on the southern end. Greenwich Point (also known as Tod's Point) is the hub for outdoor activity. With panoramic views of the Sound, the park is used for swimming, fishing, sailing, picnicking, bird watching, hiking and cycling. Seasonal park passes are available to Greenwich residents.
