

Welcome to Riverside, Connecticut

Known for its quiet, tree-lined streets, its shoreline homes and proximity to the railroad, Riverside is a section of Greenwich, nestled between Cos Cob and Old Greenwich. It spans north and south of the Post Road, also known as East Putnam Avenue and U.S. Route 1. With no center of town to speak of, Riverside's commercial hub comprises some stores and restaurants along the Post Road, and Riverside Shopping Center at the main intersection of East Putnam and the Exit 5 off ramp of Interstate 95.

As of the 2010 Census, Riverside had a population of 8,416. The average sales price of a Riverside home in 2017 so far is \$2.270M, up 10.8% from the average of \$2.049M in all of 2016.

Riverside is in great proximity to the town's parks, including the 22-acre Binney Park and the 147-acre Greenwich Point, both in Old Greenwich. Cos Cob Park, the town's newest green space addition, is also not far. Tennis courts open to town residents may be found behind Eastern Middle School, as well as at Binney Park,

just down the hill. Greenwich Point offers panoramic views of Long Island Sound, and the park is used for swimming, fishing, sailing, picknicking, bird watching, walking, hiking and cycling. Seasonal park passes are available to Greenwich residents.
